Travel Information

Air Travel: Book your flights to (CHA) Airport (6.5 miles from the conference location) by May 30, 2024. USAA will only reimburse main cabin fares. If you book your flight after May 30, you will only be reimbursed at 50% of the main cabin cost.

If you have booked your flight, you must send the information via the <u>Reimbursement</u>

<u>Verification Form</u> by **June 6, 2024** to receive reimbursement for your travel cost.

Ground Transportation: You are responsible for your transportation to/from the airport.

Personal Transportation: If driving, you will be reimbursed at .67 cents per mile up to \$500.



I am passionate about supporting superintendents as they lead our districts across the country.


Now more than ever we need courageous leaders who will step up and provide educational opportunities for our students.
